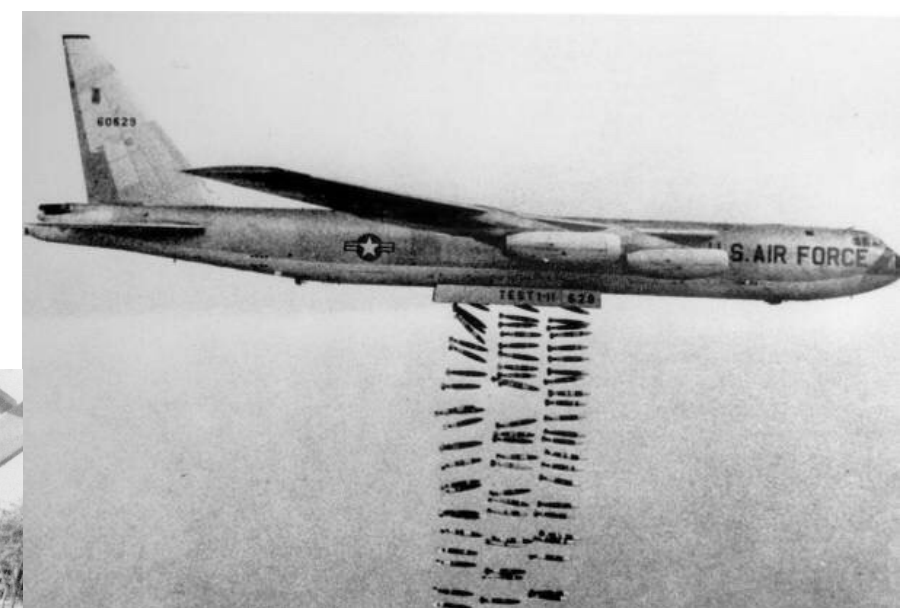
A Americans

The plane that took soldiers from Vietnam back to the US.



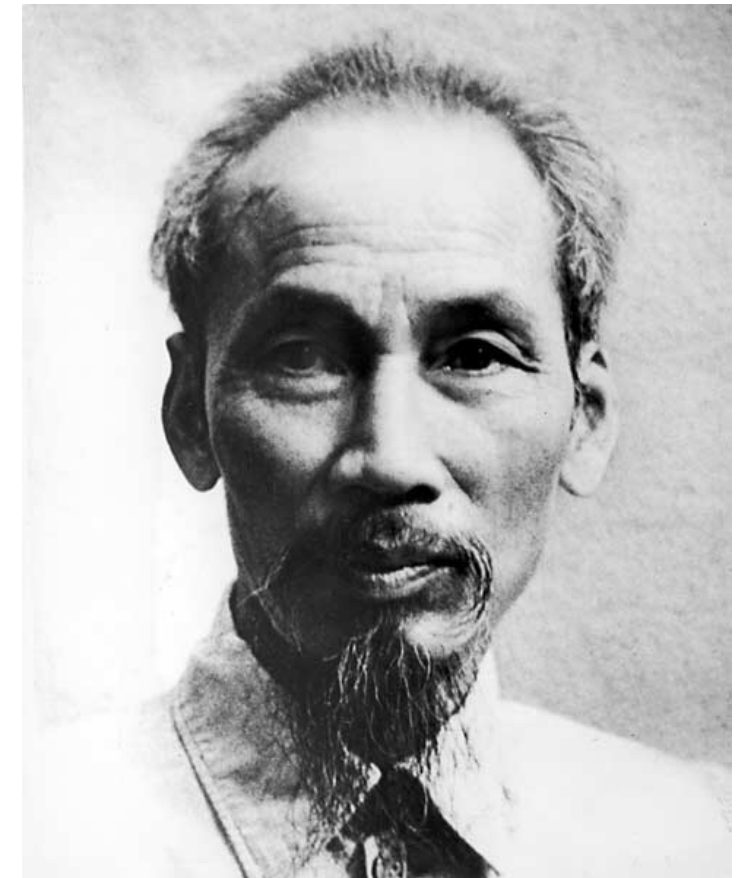
G Gulf of Tonkin

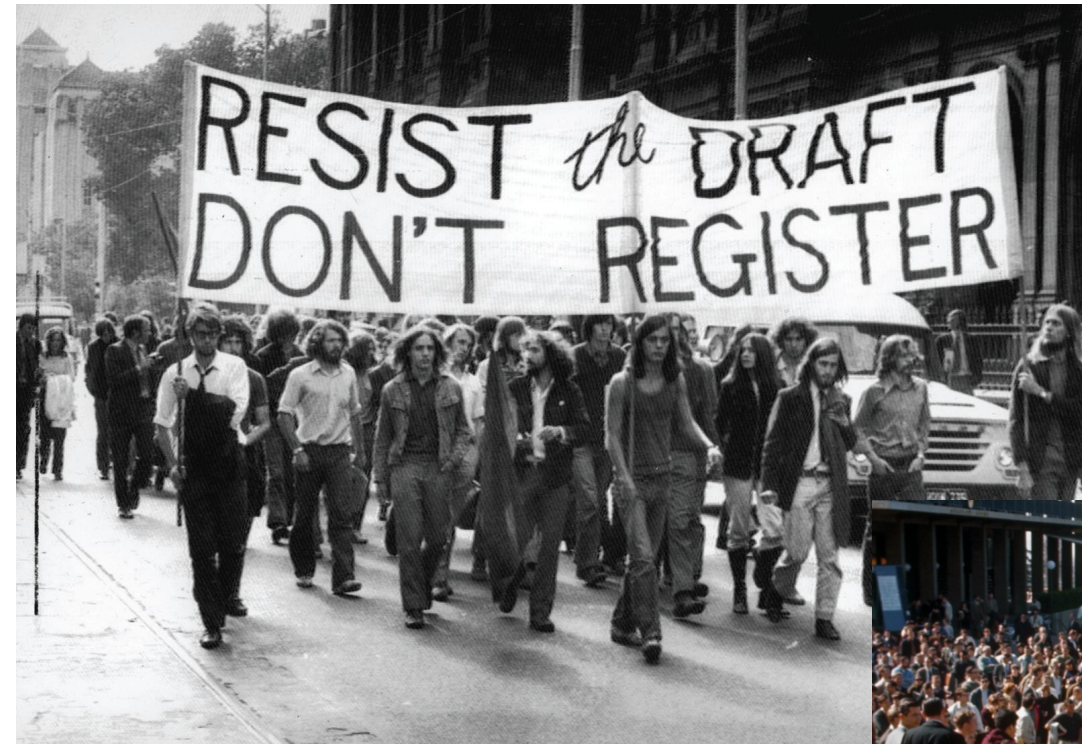
O Operating room

They had thousands of people in and out of them.



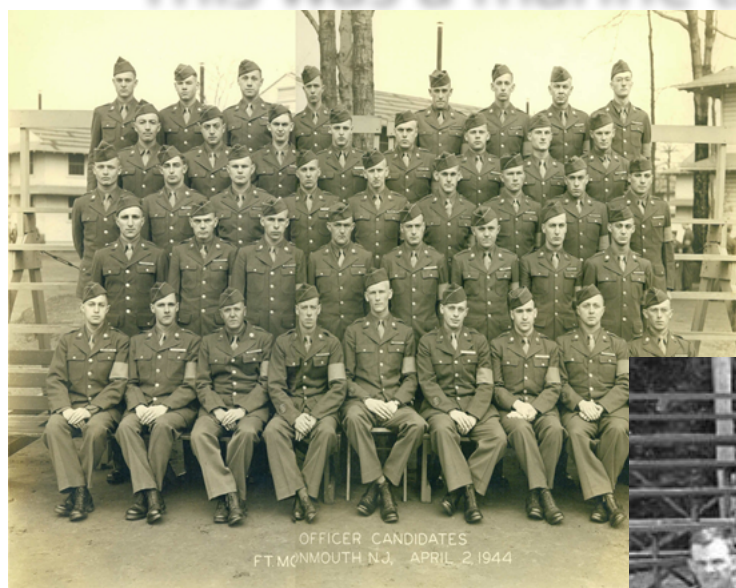
P Protests
